

CHANGES TO AATB STANDARDS FOR TISSUE BANKING

SECTION D - ACQUISITION OF TISSUE: AUTHORIZATION, INFORMED CONSENT, DONOR SCREENING, AND TISSUE RECOVERY AND COLLECTION

D1.000 GENERAL POLICIES FOR TISSUE RECOVERY OR COLLECTION ORGANIZATIONS

Current (13th edition)

In addition to the requirements at the series of standards at B1.500 Multi-Facility Tissue Banking, all referral arrangements with organ procurement organizations, Donor Referral Sources, and other tissue banks shall be documented.

- (A) The tissue bank shall establish written or verbal procedures for interacting with operating room staff, the patient's physician, or other sources/facilities for autologous tissue donation prior to *Recovery*.

(with amendments)

In addition to the requirements at the series of standards at B1.500 Multi-Facility Tissue Banking, all referral arrangements with organ procurement organizations, Donor Referral Sources, and other tissue banks shall be documented.

- (A,LD) *Except for a Reproductive Tissue Bank*, shall establish written or verbal procedures for interacting with operating room staff, the patient's physician, or other sources/facilities shall *be established* prior to *Recovery*, for autologous tissue donation.

(as amended)

In addition to the requirements at the series of standards at B1.500 Multi-Facility Tissue Banking, all referral arrangements with organ procurement organizations, Donor Referral Sources, and other tissue banks shall be documented.

- (LD) Except for a *Reproductive Tissue Bank*, written procedures for interacting with operating room staff, the patient's physician, or other sources/facilities shall be established.

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
