E4.200 Expiration Date/Storage Period

The maximum storage period for tissue shall be appropriate to the type of tissue, packaging, and *Processing*, as well as to its intended application. Expiration dates should be qualified to demonstrate that the packaging is suitable to maintain product integrity (e.g., sterility, moisture content) for the entire shelf life.
